What is Superstrings?

Superstrings is a dynamic organisation founded in 1995, that runs after-school music clubs for children aged 5-18, annual music camps and outreach projects in schools. It provides a unique service in our area by championing stringed instruments and creating platforms for young people to experience the huge benefits of collective music making. It is effective because our core belief is that by giving children the chance to meet and make music, they will naturally begin to motivate and inspire each other. This theory has proved true time and again over the years Superstrings has been running.

Dates and Venue

1st – 4th August 2018 (Wed, Thurs Fri and Sat) at Braeside, Devizes.

Course 1 – Juniors Age 5-10

Standard - Beginners to Grade 3

Daily timetable 9.30–4.00 (Please bring a packed lunch) Course 1 students will have a busy and fun four days. The course will include playing in chamber and orchestral groups, singing, and exploring the Kodály and Dalcroze methods with movement. They will also be led by our art specialist in sessions to produce filmthemed artwork.

Course 2 - Seniors Age 10-18 (Residential)

Standard - Grade 3 - 8

Daily timetable 9.30 - until late!

Course 2 students will explore, rehearse and perform chosen works from the rich and varied chamber music repertoire, play as an orchestra, learn to improvise and sing in a choir. Each evening will be fun-filled for the residents with activities including quizzes, a talent show and film night.

End of Festival Concerts

There will be three concerts during the festival, to which families and friends are warmly invited. Chamber Music concerts will be held at Braeside with Course 1 performing on Friday afternoon and Course 2 performing on Friday evening. There will be an orchestral concert for both courses on the Saturday afternoon at a local Devizes venue.
