### The tutors will include:

Elizabeth Anderson has performed most of the major Cello Concertos and given numerous solo and chamber music recitals. As founder of Superstrings and teacher of cello and chamber music, both privately and at Wells Cathedral School, she has dedicated her life to teaching.

Catherine Lord trained as a violinist at RCM and Juilliard. She performed as soloist and in chamber groups both in the USA and UK. She has taught at junior RCM, the Guildhall School and is senior violin tutor at Wells Cathedral School.

Iona Hassan studied viola at the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama with James Durrant, Cathy Marwood and then in London with Philip Dukes. She has freelanced with many of the top orchestras in the UK, ran the Junior Violin Scheme at Wells Cathedral School for a number of years and is Artistic Director of the Auriga Strings.

Daphne Moody studied at the Royal Academy of Music with Frederick Grinke. She has played with the Calgary Philharmonic, Halle, Bournemouth and London Festival Orchestras and toured extensively with the London Festival Orchestra and is the leader of La Folia. In recent years she has devoted her life to Chamber music with the Eberle Quartet and has recorded to great acclaim with them on the NAIM label. Daphne has enjoyed teaching at Trinity Junior College, Cricklade College and with Superstrings.

Rosanne Jardine has been involved with Dalcroze Eurythmics for ten years. She teaches all brass instruments at Dauntsey's School and in Bath, and runs numerous groups including a Big Band. Rosanne is also a highly skilled academic music teacher.

Charlotte White runs the Trowbridge Superstrings group at Bellefield school. She has developed a specialism in teaching music to young children using her Early Years teaching experience and Dalcroze Eurythmy; an holistic approach to teaching music.

Excellent tuition on all string instruments is given by highly qualified teachers, and pupils regularly achieve merit or distinction in public music examinations, as well as obtaining acholarships to prestigious schools.
