Age 5-10 Beginners to Grade 3

Singing and movement will be explored using the Kodály and Dalcroze methods. The students will be led by our art specialist in sessions producing imaginative and fun artwork.

Senior Course

Age 10-18 Standard Grade 3-8

Daily timetable 9.30 – 4.00 (Please bring a packed lunch) Intermediate and advanced players will explore, rehearse and perform works from the rich and varied chamber music repertoire and play as an orchestra, learn to improvise and sing in a choir. They will also be led by our art specialists in sessions producing imaginative and fun artwork.

There will be two concerts during the festival to which families and friends are warmly invited. Course participants will be involved in both concerts. Chamber Music Concert on Wednesday 17th April at Dauntsey's Manor and an Orchestral concert on Thursday 18th at 4pm at Market Lavington Community Hall.
